Although JavaScript requires a scripting host application, it is not tied to any particular implementation. The language is developed and standardized by the ECMA

independently of the scripting hosts. The scripting host in a Web browser exposes the "host objects" such as window, document (DOM) and location objects to the JavaScript engine. Similarly, in Adobe Reader, Adobe Acrobat and other applications, the viewer exposes several host objects to the JavaScript engine.
